



## CASEY'S LAW ASSESSMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (CLASP SCHOLARSHIPS)

Residents in the Louisville, Kentucky metro county area who are petitioning the court under Casey's Law may be able to receive financial assistance for the two required evaluations by qualified healthcare professionals through the **CITIZENS Attacking Addiction** *Casey's Law Assessment Scholarship Program* (CLASP).

**CITIZENS Attacking Addiction (CAA)** will pay a qualified healthcare provider a subsidiary\* for the qualified physician, and a subsidiary\* for the second qualified provider. A qualified healthcare provider is a professionally certified individual required to perform the evaluation and complete the Casey's Law certification forms.

### Eligibility Requirements

#### In order to qualify for a CLASP Scholarship:

- Petitioner must file in Jefferson County- Respondent must currently reside in Jefferson County
- Petitioner must meet guidelines based upon household size, income, and an explanation of how petitioner has been financially impacted by the respondent's addiction (e.g.: how much you have paid for their past treatment, their housing, insurance deductibles, stolen money from you [approximate] etc....)
- Complete a pre-screen application by phone interview with a **CAA** representative

#### Applicants are not eligible if:

- Petitioner has applied and received assistance through **CLASP** within the past year on same Respondent
- Petitioner fails to complete a **CLASP** application with required documents (W2, SSI, disability, etc..)
- Petitioner fails to provide a signed document of how you have personally been impacted financially by Respondent
- Petitioner is a "no show" to the scheduled evaluations, even if Respondent does not show, Petitioner must attend the evaluations, have the 703 A form completed by evaluators, and turn in the required 703 A form to courts within 24 hours. If Respondent is a "no show" he/she may be found in contempt of court. So, it is essential Petitioner still attend each evaluation, even if Respondent refuses to be evaluated.

### Next Steps

When all eligibility requirements have been met, he or she, will be contacted by a **CAA** representative within 24 hours, who will complete an assessment and provide information.
